

2010 Rocky Mountain Region Region Sanction Program

The purpose of this program is to encourage greater participation in region events and the region championship program by the clubs and members of the Rocky Mountain Region.

This program includes all types of Corvette events. In addition to sanctioning events at the National level, we will also sanction for the Rocky Mountain Region. Events sanctioned for our region will essentially be treated like non-sanctioned National events with a few changes, and points will be awarded. There will still be National sanctions and non-sanctions available.

Listed below are the guidelines for a region sanction:

- (A) Events must be open to all Rocky Mountain Region members.
- (B) Events must involve the use of a Corvette.
- (C) A Rocky Mountain Region sanction request must be received by the RCD at least 30 days prior to the event date.
- (D) Each region governor must receive a flyer of the event at least 15 days prior to the event.
- (E) All NCCC classifications and safety requirements must be followed.
- (F) Points will be awarded per the NCCC Rulebook. For events where entrants are not scored, such as driving schools, parades, color runs, etc., each entrant will receive 3 points. Points earned at events outside of the Rocky Mountain Region do not count toward the region championship program, with the exception that NCCC National Convention attendees from the Rocky Mountain Region will receive 15 points for attending and 5 points for each event entered.
- (G) A club will receive club points upon completion of all required paperwork for events they host. National sanctioned events will receive 100 club points and Region sanctioned events will receive 75 club points. These points will be given for a club's first seven events with National sanctioned events taking precedence. If a club hosts more than seven events, they will be awarded 25 points or the total of the points earned by their members who entered or worked that event, whichever is greater. Club points will also be awarded for the points their members earn participating in other Rocky Mountain Region clubs' events covered under this program.
- (H) The \$5/per event sanction fee (for National and Region sanctioned events) must be remitted to the RCD when the event results and waivers are submitted.
- (I) Failure to follow the above guidelines will result in loss of points for the host club and its members for that event per the NCCC Rulebook.

Public safety must be the primary consideration at every event.
