

Rocky Mountain Region Region Sanction Program

The purpose of this program is to encourage greater participation in region events and the region championship program by the clubs and members of the Rocky Mountain Region.

The Rocky Mountain Region competition program will follow all aspects of the National (NCCC) competition program/rulebook with the following exceptions:

1. Each club may hold a maximum of 14 sanctioned events – the seven National sanctions permitted by NCCC plus up to seven Region sanctions or National sanctions borrowed from another Rocky Mountain Region club (or a combination of these). There is no limit on non-sanctioned (non-point) events.
2. There is a \$5/per event sanction fee for each National and Region-sanctioned event which must be remitted to the RCD when the event results and waivers are submitted.
3. Per NCCC, a club will receive 100 points for National sanctioned events they host under their specific club number (maximum of seven per NCCC rulebook). For Region-sanctioned events and National sanctions borrowed from other Rocky Mountain Region clubs, the club points will be the total of their member entrant points.
4. Only points earned at events sanctioned within the Rocky Mountain Region (National and Region) count toward the Region individual and club championships.
5. Points earned at Region-sanctioned events do not count toward the NCCC (National) championship program and results from those events are not submitted to National. Out-of-region entrants do not receive points for, and are not listed in, the results of Region-sanctioned events.

All requirements in the NCCC rulebook pertaining to timelines, flyers, car classes, points, rallye mileage, and waivers, among other specifics, shall be followed. **Safety is always the primary consideration and all rules regarding safety issues shall be strictly adhered to.**
